MANGROVE PLANTING AT SUNGAI KECIL

Join us for a meaningful journey to Sungai Kecil, where you can take part in protecting one of Bintan's most important coastal ecosystems.

Mangroves play a vital role in preserving the island's natural environment. Their strong roots help protect the shoreline from erosion, provide a safe habitat for marine life, and support cleaner air by absorbing carbon from the atmosphere.

During this hands-on experience, you will visit a local mangrove nursery and plant young mangrove seedlings with guidance from the community. Along the way, you will learn how mangrove conservation helps protect Bintan's coastline and supports a healthier coastal ecosystem for future generations.

This activity is perfect for guests who enjoy nature, sustainability, and meaningful outdoor experiences.

Guests are recommended to wear comfortable beachwear or casual outdoor clothing. For the comfort and safety of the hatchlings, guests should follow all guidance from the conservation team. Flash photography and direct handling may be restricted depending on conservation protocols.

This activity supports awareness of marine conservation and helps guests understand the importance of protecting sea turtles and their nesting habitats. The experience encourages responsible interaction with wildlife and promotes long-term care for Bintan’s coastal environment.

During this educational visit, you can learn how local communities care for the bees, understand their important role in the ecosystem, and taste fresh natural honey from the farm.
